Infant and Toddler Programs

6 weeks to 24 months

In our infant and toddler program we provide a calm, nurturing and educational environment. Your child will feel loved and have the opportunity to learn and grow at his/her developmental level each day. Our infant and toddler program includes opportunities for your child to interact with other little ones, to hear stories and music, to enjoy free play, and to rest in their assigned crib or nap mat. Meals and snacks are given by our loving teachers as needed for each child's schedule. The classes go for daily walks when the weather permits and enjoy time on the playground. A copy of your child's daily sheet is sent home with you so you may read about your child's day.

Pre-School Programs 2's & 3's

Our core teaching time in Pre-school program for ages 2-3 occurs each weekday from 9:00 am – noon. The Pre-school Curriculum includes a fun weekly theme and an alphabet letter of the week. We utilize A-beka curriculum, which is based on sound Christian principles, for our weekly Bible stories and memory versus. A lesson plan is posted each week in the classroom so you can read about all the fun and learning activities planned each day for your child.

Each class has playground time each day. We also have specialty classes which include a Chapel, music and movement class and physical education class. In a creative structured classroom setting our teachers incorporate listening activities, pre-reading activities, number skills, large motor and fine motor skills.

A copy of your child's daily sheet is sent home with you so you may read about your child's day.

Pre-Kindergarten Program 4's

Our core teaching time in our Pre-Kindergarten program for ages 4-5 years old occurs each weekday from 9:00 am – noon. We utilize the A beka book curriculum, which is based on sound Christian principles for all our learning BASICS—reading, writing, and numbers—and so much more! The A beka book program helps children develop valuable habits and social skills for a strong head start in elementary.

Our Pre-K program provides children the opportunity to learn, beginning with letters and sounds. Soon, students progress to reading words, sentences, and stories in their own reading books, which they take home and enjoy reading over and over. Bible stories and Bible memory versus are also a part of our daily learning.

A lesson plan is posted each week in the classroom so you can read about all the fun and learning activities planned each day for your child. A copy of your child's daily sheet is sent home with you so you may read about your child's day.

Kindergarten & 1st Grade Program

Language Arts, including Phonics, English, Spelling and Reading using the A Beka Publications:

Building on the foundation introduced to students at the kindergarten level, students continue to learn the phonograms that make up the English language by listening to them, speaking them and writing them in manuscript print. Once students begin to master the initial phonograms, they are introduced to spelling and creative writing. This strong foundation builds student confidence in their language skills and encourages them to be life-long readers. To compliment the Language Arts program, students use level appropriate books, ABC Mouse, Starfall and other independent reading using classroom-library books and reading to students from classic children's literature are an essential part of the program.

The students also have opportunities to develop creative thinking and problem solving skills as they use manipulatives to understand math concepts, develop science experiments, or recreate a period of our country's history. A Christian worldview is integrated throughout all areas of the Kindergarten and 1st grade program, allowing the students to see the touch of His hand in all of creation..

Before & After School Program

School age – 12 years old

Our program provides before and/or after school care for school age children up to 12 years old. Children who attend our center after school are provided with a nourishing snack upon their arrival and then enter into a time of supervised homework completion and studying as well as group Bible study. Once they are finished with their homework they are allowed to participate in an art activity or a center activity of their choice.

Summer Program

Our program provides all day care and supervision during the summer months for school age children up to 12 years old. This summer program is primarily for children who attend the center in the before and after school program. However, other children will be considered for admission on a space available basis. Our summer program, changes annually and is designed to provide age appropriate activities that will interest, encourage, and challenge them in learning while they have fun. We schedule a variety of fieldtrips, as well as have planned and structured in-house activities throughout the summer months. Weekly our campers spend at least 6 hours in academics with an additional minimum 2 ½ hours independently reading.

I am Nicole Brown, Chief Executive Officer, and Owner of Nikki's Christian Daycare Center, Inc. First of all I would like to thank you for considering our center as a place to provide educational support and care for your child when you cannot be there.

As a parent, I understand the concerns, questions, and even anxiety that accompany the decision before you. Nikki's Christian Daycare Center began in the Woodbridge area February 1993 as a licensed in-home center caring for 5 children. We are just as we started out, a Christ-centered, smoke free child care and learning center. We maintain a CPR and 1st aid certified staff present during daycare hours. All members of the NCCDC team must pass a criminal background check and child development services check before being employed.

I am proud of the team that stands in unity to meet the educational, developmental and care needs of our children and their parents. We do not see our ministry as a babysitting service and therefore, even with the infants, we seek ways and opportunities to nurture and encourage their development; just recently adding the highly acclaimed, early language development system, Your Baby Can Read to their daily plan. I believe in education not just for our children but for the staff as well. I ensure each member of the team annually exceeds the Virginia state standards for education and training and beyond that I have incentive programs for those on staff who are actively pursuing their CDA or other childhood related degree program.

Our center offers a variety of programs geared to meet the needs of families with children ages 6 weeks to 12 years old.
