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Virginia Preservice Training For Child Care Staff



Beginning in August 2016, the Virginia Department of Social Services (VDSS) will post a new, free, mandatory online course, “Virginia Preservice Training for Child Care Staff,” for all staff members working in a child care program that accepts VDSS subsidy funding. Health and safety preservice training is required by the federal Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 2014 and the proposed federal child care regulation. Age-relevant Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid training are required for each staff member in programs receiving subsidy funds, in addition to this preservice training. For child care staff working for a program that does NOT receive subsidy funding, this course, CPR and First Aid training are strongly encouraged.

ABOUT TRAINING

The Virginia Preservice Training is a free, ten-hour course covering the following topics:

- ▶ Foundations of child development; Transportation safety;
- ▶ Introduction to Inclusion and working with children who have special needs;
- ▶ Recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect; Prevention of shaken baby syndrome;
- ▶ Prevention and control of infectious diseases (including immunization);
- ▶ Prevention of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome and safe sleep practices;
- ▶ Administration of medication consistent with parental consent;
- ▶ Emergency preparedness and response planning from natural or man-made events;
- ▶ Introduction to Virginia’s Child Care Subsidy Program and Becoming a Licensed Program;
- ▶ **and much more!**
